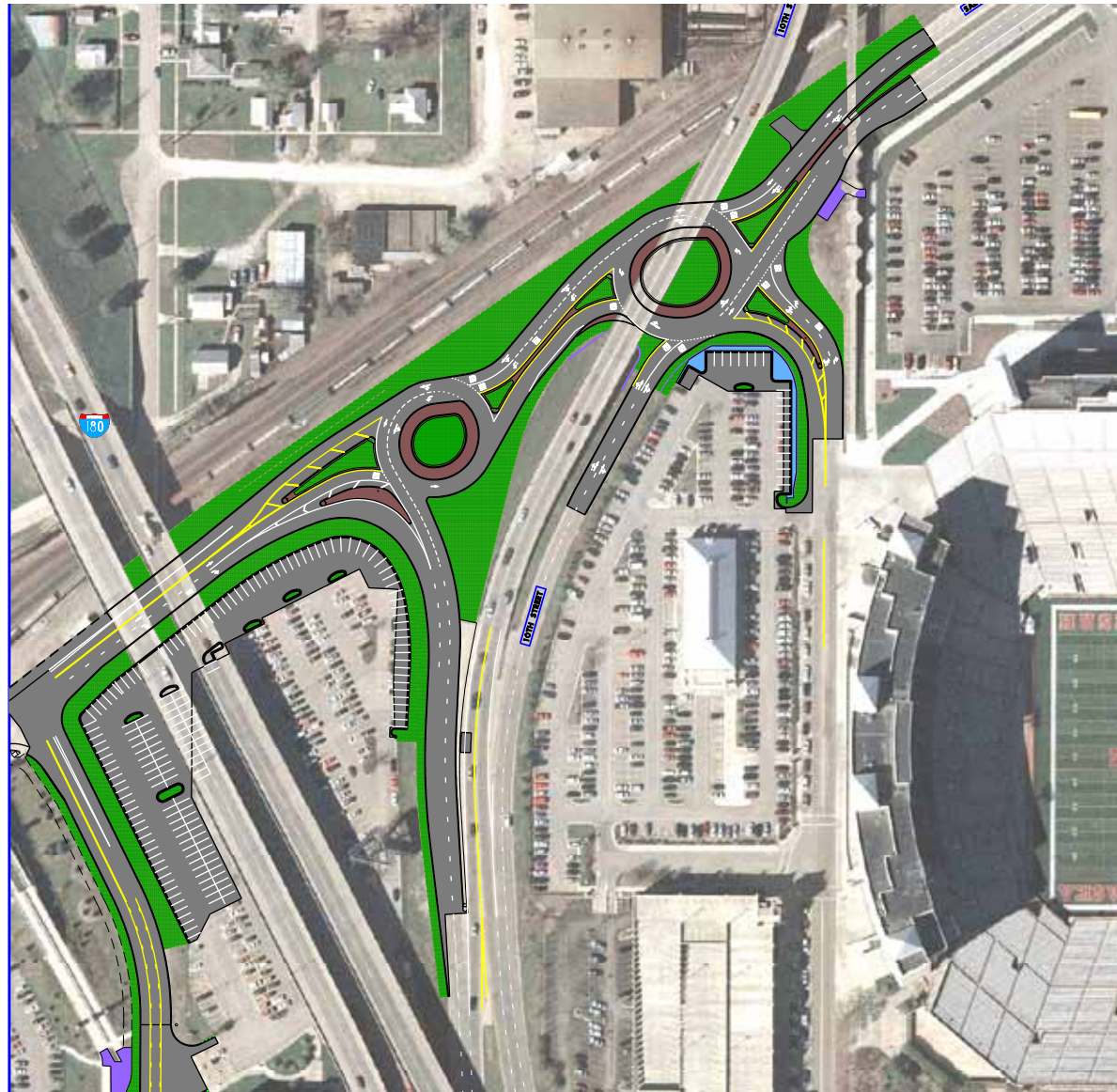

A NEW ENTRY

The Haymarket Arena project, approved by Lincolnites in May 2010, will benefit the community, the university, tourists and fans. The Joint Public Agency (JPA) charged with overseeing construction has worked with the various parties affected, including the Nebraska Champions Club.

The arena project includes road improvements in downtown Lincoln, the Haymarket and campus. Just north of the Champions Club parking lot, along Salt Creek Roadway, new roadways – with two roundabouts – will improve safety. One of these roundabouts extends south directly toward the Club parking lot.

We wanted you to be aware of these roundabouts prior to the season so you can plan the drive to your parking space accordingly. Eventually, we anticipate a smoother and safer entrance and exit from this area.

Declaration of Covenants – “First Amendment”

With this construction, the north part of the Club’s parking lot was altered. Along with this, a number of existing members encountered some shifting in the location and/or orientation of their parking space. The enclosed document, “First Amendment to The Declaration of Covenants” outlines the Nebraska Alumni Associations authority to enact these changes. Please keep this document for your records.

Power and Cable Options

At the suggestion of several members, association staff worked with local engineers to investigate the feasibility of equipping the parking lot in such a way that power and cable could be made available to any member who wished to pay for it. Unfortunately, the logistics of such a wide-scale effort make this impossible at this time. While we agree that this feature would be convenient, the best option for members who wish to enjoy electricity is to bring a store-bought generator. Please remember that, if you happen to be near power that is part of the Club, you are required to check with Club management before plugging in.

GAME DAY INFORMATION

New Vehicle Passes

Your pedestrian passes for each game are with this newsletter and, you’ll notice that you have several vehicle passes. Please make note that you have separate VEHICLE PASSES for EACH GAME. These are color-coded to match the pedestrian passes for each game. We were happy to make this change in response to numerous requests from members for extra vehicle passes. We hope this makes sharing your parking spot easier throughout the season.

Plastic Sleeves & Lanyards

We will have plenty of plastic sleeves and lanyards at the gates and Guest Relations Office for each gameday. Please re-use and recycle as much as possible.

Will-Call Booth

The Nebraska Champions Club WILL-CALL BOOTH is located directly across from the vehicle entrance on the west side of Memorial Stadium. You may leave passes at the will-call booth for guests who wish to join you at your tailgate. The booth opens three hours before kick-off and remains open until kick-off. Club staff members will be happy to deliver any items to the booth at your request.

Member/Guest Relations Office

Visit the GUEST RELATIONS OFFICE (in the club plaza) with any questions or tailgating needs you have (lanyards, cups, first-aid, etc.). Staff are available throughout the day for your convenience. We encourage members to leave a note with the staff here if you have tickets to sell or need extra tickets – they can direct other members/guests to your stall.

Football Rules

Should you or your guests have the urge to throw a football around the Champions Club, please observe our game day guidelines to avoid injury and damage to personal property:

- Limited to soft nerf-type balls, regulation footballs are prohibited.
- Prohibited from one hour before kick-off through kick-off, and for one hour after the end of the game.
- Long bombs and punting are prohibited.

Extra Pedestrian Passes

The option to request and purchase additional pedestrian passes was made available with the letter mailed in July about the annual assessment. At this time, ADDITIONAL PASSES ARE NOT AVAILABLE.

Champions Club Rules

- 1 Vehicles entering the Champions Club gates must display their vehicle hang tag on the rearview mirror. To promote smooth traffic flow and prevent backups, proceed to your parking space and then notify a staff member of any specific needs you have.
- 2 Anyone entering the gates either in a vehicle or on foot must have a guest pass visibly displayed on their person. While inside the gates or clubhouse, please make sure your guest pass is visible at all times.
- 3 Members are to handle the distribution of their guest passes prior to each game day. Guests cannot enter through the gates without a pass.
- 4 When parking your vehicle and tailgating, it is each member’s responsibility to ensure that overlapping does not occur or occurs only as agreed upon by neighboring members.
- 5 The Nebraska Champions Club is located on property owned by the University of Nebraska and is therefore governed by the university’s strict and limited alcohol policies. Underage or excessive drinking by club patrons will jeopardize the club’s ability to serve alcohol and will not be allowed. Nebraska Champions Club members are responsible for the behavior of their guests. No alcohol will be served before 10 a.m., and no open containers such as commercial bottles and cans are allowed. Only alcoholic beverages purchased on site may be consumed at the Champions Club.
- 6 Any time you leave through the gates, on foot or in a vehicle, ALL beverages must be discarded or left behind.
- 7 The Alumni Association reserves the sole and exclusive right to establish the rules and regulations for use of the facility, including the extent and nature of guest privileges.

For thorough and additional definitions of the rules, refer to your copy of the Nebraska Champions Club Declaration of Covenants. If you do not have a copy of the covenants, please let us know and we will mail you a copy.
